## Freezing weather while you are not living in your home

- Find your main street shut-off valve and make sure it can be turned off.
- Turn off the water and drain header tanks and hot water cylinder.
- Arrange for someone to check on your home at least once a week during the winter season.



If you aren't sure how to shut off the water to your house or appliances, talk to a plumber.

Cover for damage caused by burst pipes is normally provided in standard household insurance. Always check the details on your own policy as cover could vary.

## Should your pipes freeze and burst

- 1. Turn off your water supply at the street. If you can't, contact a plumber.
- 2. If water is leaking out of the ceiling or the walls, turn off your electricity at the meter box. Call an electrician immediately.
- 3. Protect personal possessions and documents.
- 4. Open doors and windows wherever you can to allow your property to dry out.
- 5. Phone your insurer. They will tell you what to do next.
